Joey's

Joey's, is an Italian staple in the Wynwood neighbourhood, the vision of the late Tony Goldman. Located adjacent to Wynwood Walls, this restaurant showcases elegant design alongside a mellow, convivial ambience. The dining room at Joey's offers respite to a diverse crowd, catering for performing arts troupes as well as couples and friends wishing to enjoy a delicious meal or a drink on the outdoor terrace. Begin with the beef Carpaccio, a mix of arugula, shaved grana padano cheeses and a truffle mayo appetizer followed by the gorgonzola *tartufata* pizza, which consists of gorgonzola cheese, walnuts and truffle oil topped with arugula. The classic spaghetti pomodoro is great for an entrée selection, and especially when followed up with a rich [Argentinian](#) malbec.

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
